December, 2025 A Letter from Pastor Hansen

As many of you know, emails under my name were sent out from fraudulent email accounts on November 17. This is not the first time I have been impersonated, and it will not be the last. I write these annual reminders about text messages or emails impersonating me or others, because we all need to be reminded about how difficult it is to discern whether you and I are getting scammed or not.

Just this past fall, I got an email that looked like it was from the Executive Director of Camp Whitman, Bryan Mueke. It was not. It looked like it. The email certainly did not stand out as a scam. But it was. It wanted me to sign into a fraudulent OneDrive account. I tried multiple times and, thankfully, it did not work. The moment I found out what had happened, I changed my passwords before someone changed my passwords for me. I was lucky.

Part of what happened to the people who got the email "from me" is that the people who were impersonating me set up Gmail accounts that told the recipients of the emails that the email was from me. Scammers do not have to hack into my email account to trick someone, they just have to open an email account and tell it to tell people it is from me. And because we are so used to the vast majority of our emails not lying to us about who sent them, we do not take the extra step to examine the actual email address.

The email supposedly sent to me by Bryan Mueke and the emails supposedly from me to many of you were more sophisticated than the run of the mill, I need you to buy me gift cards scam. They did not ask for money or gift cards. They merely asked us to respond.

So, what do we do? A couple of reminders. First, I will never text you or email you asking for gift cards, iTunes cards, Apple Cards, or Amazon cards. Second, if the email or text uses your full, given name and I have never called you by that name, it is not from me. Third, if I am really going to ask you to do something out of the ordinary, I am probably going to call you and not email or text you. Fourth, and I think that this is the most important tip, take your time and do not feel the need to instantly respond. And lastly, verify. Call the office. Talk it over with someone you trust.

As followers of Christ, we are called to be generous with our time, our skills, our energy, and our resources; and unfortunately, this is what people who target churches and other communities of faith are counting on. Let us not respond by becoming less generous or being less helpful or by becoming cynical. Rather, let us respond by slowing down, taking a breath, and understanding that there is huge difference between someone who is hungry and in need of food and a scam. The first we are called to respond to in love, the second, we are called to ignore, so that we can continue to respond in love to the first.







Motion to adjourn made by Steve Allison, seconded by Cheryl Allison. Motion CARRIED.




